A tough customer: the new RO*57 flex

The requirements for towing hitches in Scandinavia are high. Extreme temperatures and the volume of traffic – even off tarmacked roads – call for extra robust couplings.

There is a new addition to ROCKINGER's range of towing hitches for Scandinavia. The RO*57 introduced at the last International Motor Show (IAA) is now being joined by the new RO*57 flex. This robust coupling for 57.5 mm drawbar eyes complying with the Swedish norm is particularly well suited to multi-axle drawbar trailers. It features the tried and tested bearing used in the RO*50 flex and is designed for demanding on and off-road use with a D value of up to 260 kN. The specially designed rubber bearing increases cross-country mobility for use off tarmacked roads. A rotating bolt ensures even wear. And should repairs ever become necessary, the split funnel and ROCKINGER's modular system make it really easy.

A special grease filling makes the coupling low-maintenance and suitable for use even in extreme temperatures. Thanks to a tailor-made locking system, mounting the RO*57 flex on the vehicle is easy. It is available with a pneumatic remote control, which is also available as a retrofit kit.
